HEVEA WOOD

Adding warmth and elegance, either side of the Hevea countertop is available to you, giving you more flexibility for a personalized look to match any design aesthetic.

Tree

- 75 feet tall x 3 feet diameter / 90 trees per acre
- 6 years to mature
- 19 to 25 years of latex production before trees dies and is harvested

Properties

- Easy to saw, machine, plane, turn, bore
- Easy to finish due to smooth surface
- Fastener hold equals hardwood
- Maple family - dense grain character - easily controlled in kiln dry process - minimal shrinkage

Environmental

- Most ecologically “friendly” lumber used in today’s furniture industry
- Unlike other woods cut exclusively to produce furniture, Hevea is harvested after it completes it’s latex producing cycles & dies



ACACIA WOOD

The wood grain variation of Acacia brings unique beauty and sophistication. Either side of the Acacia countertop can be used. One side is light with dark grains and the other is dark with light grains.

Tree

- 50 feet to 90 feet tall x 3 feet to 5 feet diameter
- Ready to harvest in as little as 5 years
- 15 to 20 year lifespan

Properties

- Easy to saw, machine, plane, turn, bore
- Easy to finish due to smooth surface
- Long-lasting wood - durability to scratch resistance
- Adaptable to poor soil types - less susceptible to disease and fast growing

Environmental

- Plays an important role acting as a nurse crop for native forest regeneration by enriching and fertilizing the soil
- Fixes loose soil structures to prevent floods/landslides
- Acacia plantations reduce greenhouse gases

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR CENTERPOINTE FLOATING SHELVES

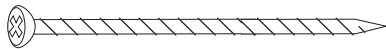
- **CAUTION:** The maximum shelf capacity when properly installed into wood wall studs:
 - 50 lbs. for each of the two 72" shelves (2-PACK).
 - 50 lbs. for the 48" shelf and 25 lbs. for each of the two 24" shelves (3-PACK).
- For indoor installation only.
- Do not install shelves into metal wall studs.
- To clean your CenterPointe Floating Shelves, simply wipe clean with a damp cloth. Do not utilize abrasive cleaners or cleaning tools. Always test cleaning products in an inconspicuous area first.

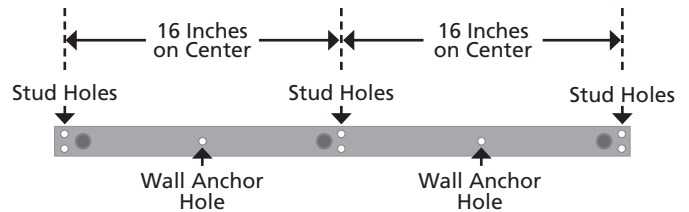
STEP 1: LOCATE & MARK WALL STUD



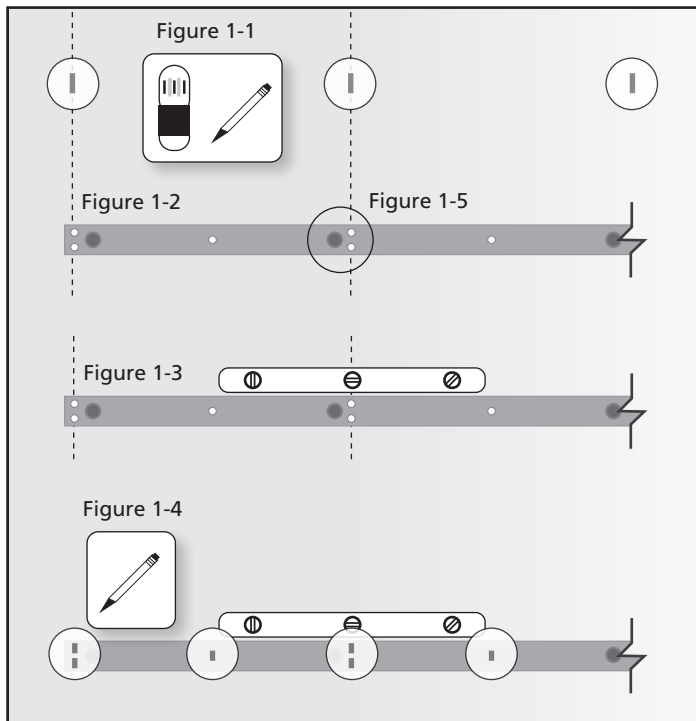
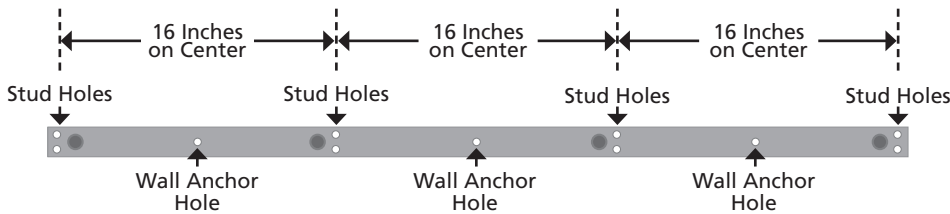

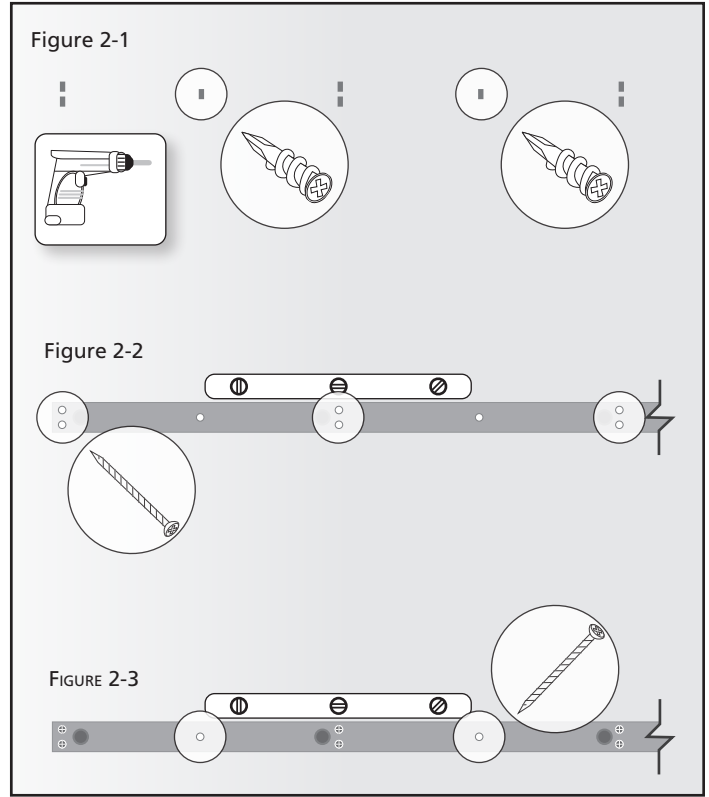
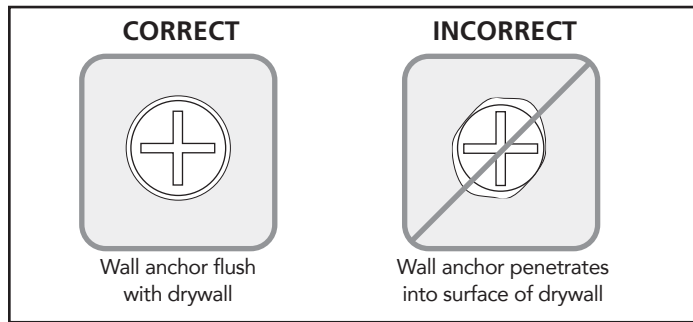
To properly and safely install your CenterPointe Floating Shelves, **it is imperative to attach your shelves to the wall studs**. Using your stud-finder device, locate the wall studs and lightly mark their location on the wall with a pencil (Figure 1-1). Then remove the mounting bracket from the shelf. Test fit the bracket to the wall making sure to align the two screw holes with the stud locations you marked on the wall (Figure 1-2). Use the level to ensure the bracket is level (Figure 1-3). Finally using a pencil, mark the bracket screw locations with a pencil (Figure 1-4).

Note: On the 48" mounting bracket the center stud holes must be located to the right of the center rod. (Figure 1-5)

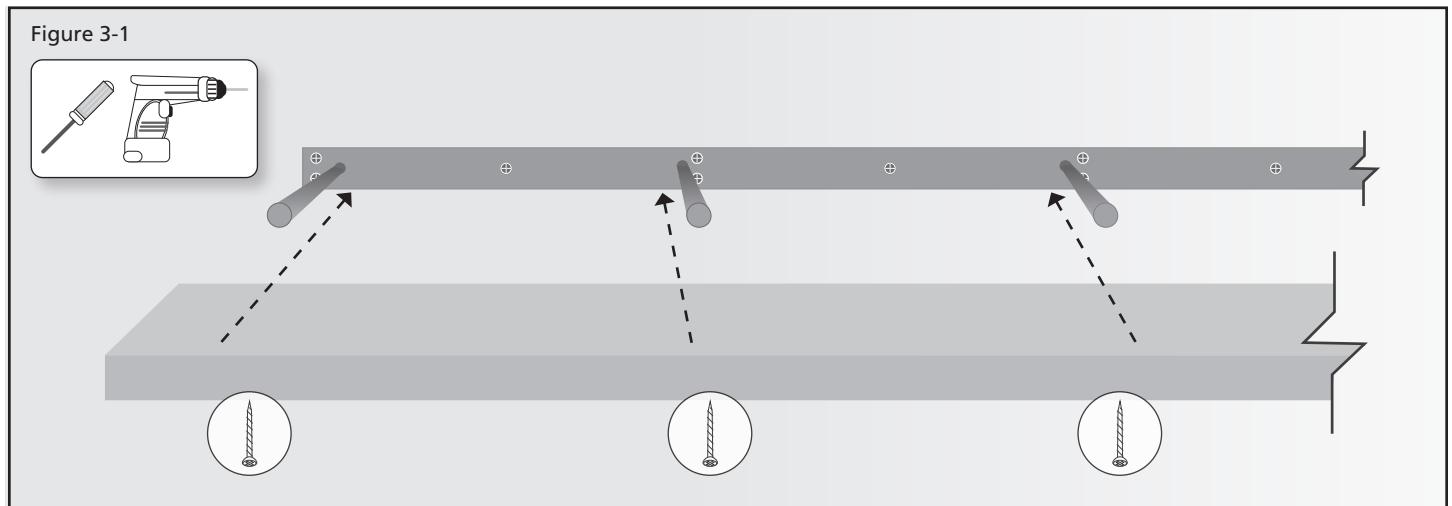
VT CenterPointe FLOATING SHELVES KIT INSTALLATION

First, install the self-tapping wall anchors in the single screw locations of the bracket. Using a drill, screw the wall anchors into the wall, making sure that the lip of the anchor is flush with the drywall and that it doesn't penetrate beyond the surface of the drywall (Figure 2-1). Next, locate the 2-inch mounting screws and screw them into the ends (double hole locations) first and then into the single hole locations (Figure 2-2) and into the wall anchors, making sure the bracket remains level throughout the process (Figure 2-3).

STEP 3: SLIDE SHELVES ON BRACKET AND SECURE INTO PLACE



Align the mounting bracket with the pre-drilled holes on the back side of the shelf and slide into place. Locate the 1-1/8 inch finishing screws and using a drill, screw them into the pre-drilled holes on the face of the shelf (Figure 3-1). Repeat process with additional shelves.

The following care and maintenance instructions will help extend the life and performance of your CenterPointe wood countertop.

Prior to Installation:

Keep product in its packaging and away from humidity or direct heat until you are ready to install it. The wood may bow slightly upward at the edges if it is stored for a long period of time. To return the surface to its original condition, turn it over and lay it on its face until it's reformed to its original shape. Check the color and finish of your surface before installation. You cannot return or exchange the product once it has been altered or installed. Keep in mind that wood is a natural material, so each surface can vary slightly in color, tone, and characteristics. This adds to its beauty.

TO PREVENT MOISTURE DAMAGE, SEAL YOUR WOOD SURFACE IMMEDIATELY (WITHIN 24 HOURS) AFTER REMOVING THE PACKAGING AND THE CLEAR PLASTIC WRAP. MAKE SURE ALL RAW SURFACES AND BARE EDGES ARE COVERED. CENTERPOINTE RECOMMENDED PRODUCTS FOR SEALING ARE: HOWARD OIL (raw wood needs 3-4 coats), HOWARD CONDITIONER (applied after oil, once a month to rejuvenate), OR VARATHANE POLYURETHANE.

During Installation:

Reseal any area that have been cut with at least 3-4 coats of sealer. Always use protective equipment when cutting and installing the wood countertops.

For Daily Use:

Wash the countertop immediately after each use with a mild dish soap and water taking care to thoroughly dry the surface. Do not use harsh or abrasive cleansers or chemicals to clean the countertop. Do not place hot items directly on the surface. Avoid cutting directly on the wood, as this could damage the surface. If you choose an oil finish, keep in mind there is maintenance required. Depending on how dry the environment is, it could require oiling every other week. Otherwise, once a month is good according to wood top manufacturers.

Warranty:

This surface comes with a 90-day limited warranty.

Exchanges or refunds are available for products damaged during fabrication. Such damage may include delamination and joint separation. This warranty does not cover damage caused by improper storage, handling, alteration, or installation. Be sure to carefully read the care and maintenance instructions. Immediately report any damage due to transportation. If the package appears to be damaged upon receipt, open the package and thoroughly inspect the product.
